What is this product?

Type This product is a Guernsey authorised Class B open-ended collective investment scheme incorporated as a

protected cell company.

ObjectivesThe investment objective of the Fund is to maximise the long term total return on assets whilst maintaining the

preservation of capital. The product will primarily invest in global equities either through specialist funds or by direct investment. The specialist funds may be established in different jurisdictions to the product, which will be identified in the reports for the product. Uninvested cash balances may vary according to the investment outlook and may represent a significant proportion of product assets during periods of expected poor returns. The product may engage in short sales, that is, the practice of selling securities which are borrowed from a third

party, if future declines in the price of securities are expected.

Intended Investor This product is best suited for sophisticated investors who are willing to tolerate a high level of volatility in the

value of their investment. Investors should have a time horizon of at least five years.

Term This product is open ended.

What are the risks and what could you get in return?



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 5 out of 7, which is a mediumhigh risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium-high level, and poor market conditions will likely impact our capacity to pay you.

The manager may choose to employ gearing of up to 25%, invest in derivatives and the product may be exposed to FX risk.

Investment Performance Information

The Fund's investment objective is to generate long term returns for shareholders whilst maintaining the preservation of capital and does so by investing primarily in global equities either through specialist funds or by direct investment. The Benchmark Return for the Fund is a rate equal to a 60:40 composite of the United States of the US CPI annual inflation rate and the Eurozone CPI annual inflation rate respectively plus 2% per annum.

What could affect my return positively?

The Fund is designed to produce positive returns through investing in a diversified portfolio. The Fund does not track any specific index however, returns of the Fund are correlated to the global equity market. A sustained period of growth in the global equity markets may result in higher returns for investors.

What could affect my return negatively?

Due to the correlation with the global equity markets the Fund's returns may be negatively affected during a sustained period of declining growth in the global equity markets. There is no assurance that the Company's investments will be profitable.

Based on historic performance of the Company during a recession, like the event during the first quarter of 2022, in severely adverse market conditions performance is expected to be reduced to a limited extent.

What happens if Hanseatic Asset Management LBG is unable to pay out?

What are the costs?
